The more reading children do, the more quickly they will develop as readers! It is often recommended that beginning readers spend 10 to 20 minutes reading each day (in addition to the reading they do at school). I completely understand after school routines and activities become busy and hectic and that these little ones are exhausted from being in school for 6+ hours. The amount of reading a child does is most important, not the amount of time he/she spends doing it. If your child spends 20 minutes reading a book that is very challenging, he/she will read less (in terms of the total number of words read) than if he/she spends the same 20 minutes reading easier books. Also note that beginning readers generally benefit from reading to someone and many will not be interested in reading alone. Reading to your child each night is just as beneficial as your child reading aloud to you.
