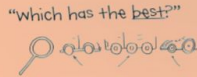

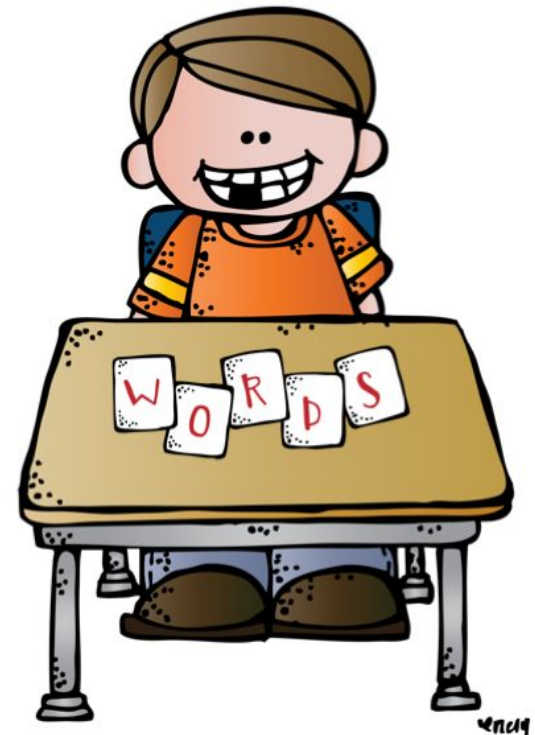
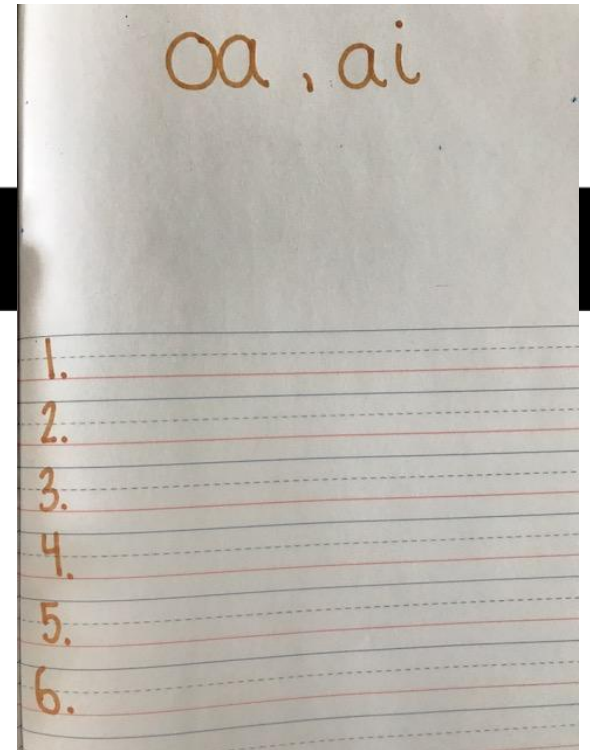
Ready, set, prepare your tools! Word builders, today we will use what we learned about building words to do a **quick check** in our notebooks.

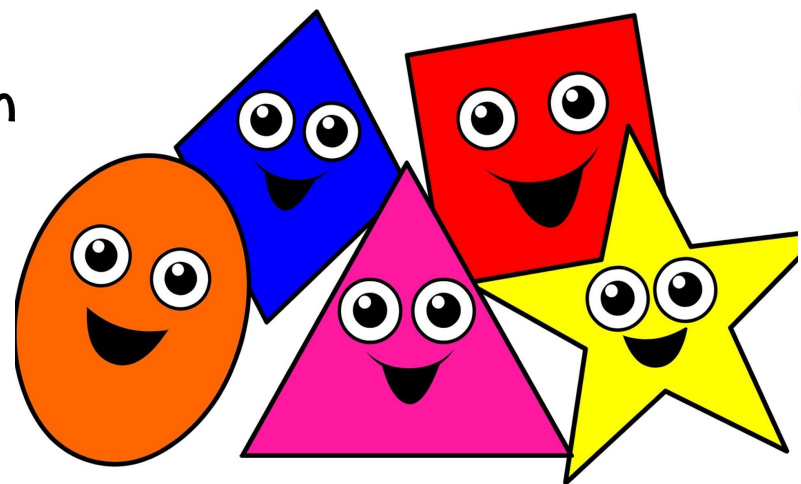

Lesson 12.1
Sort Two-Dimensional Shapes
Here are some ways to sort two-dimensional shapes.

side → square → vertex

A square is a special kind of rectangle.

curved and closed shapes: circles

closed shapes with 3 sides: triangles

closed shapes with 4 vertices: rectangles

Vertices (corners) are where the sides meet.

Vertices are more than one vertex.

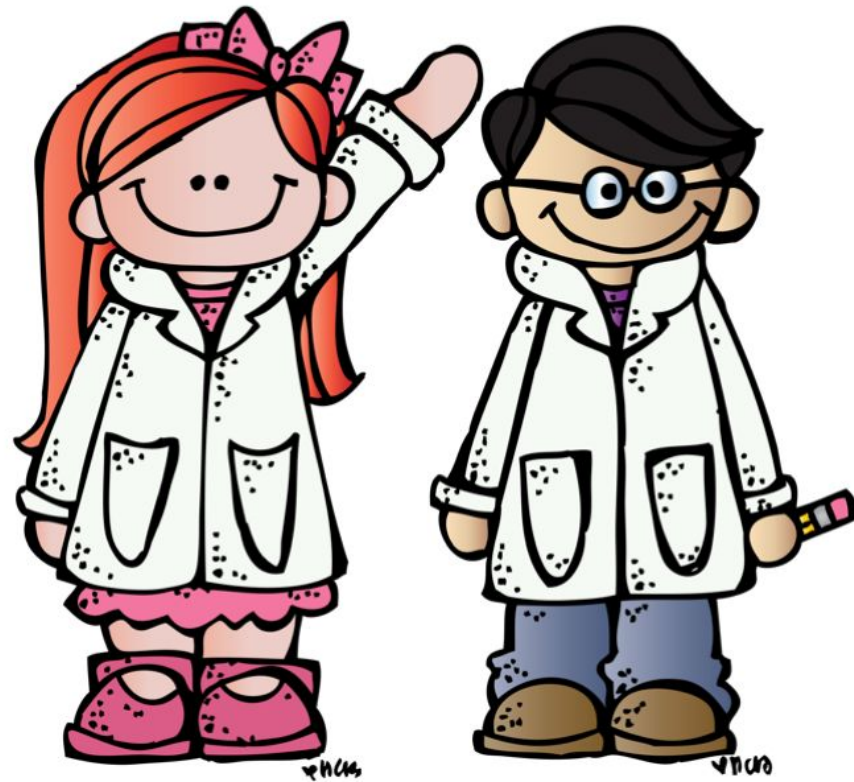
