Good morning and I hope that you and your children had a smooth start to the school year and a nice weekend! It was wonderful to welcome all of our students back to full time instruction last week, to see them in their new classes, to see their smiles (even behind their masks) as they reconnected with friends and others, and to see them enjoying lunch and recess! While we still need to have restrictions and adjustments in place for everyone's health and safety, last week definitely felt much more like a "normal" reopening.

I am aware, however, that there have been some issues and concerns with our timing and transportation processes as they relate to arrival and dismissal. These types of situations are common at the beginning of any school year, but they can be annoying and stressful nonetheless. Please know that all of us would like nothing better than to fully return to the normal timing and procedures that were in place prior to COVID, but unfortunately we are not there yet. We are, however, continually working to adjust schedules and protocols wherever feasible in order to make each day smoother than the last while remaining steadfast in our commitment to maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all. Specifically, please note the following:

- We have already implemented changes to our dismissal procedures at Beechwood which significantly reduced wait time for parents in the afternoon.
- We are working to adjust our timing for opening the doors to Beechwood in the morning as we know that every minute counts for both students and parents.
- We are communicating with our transportation company and Governor Livingston High School in order to address a delay that appears to be impacting the timing of our afternoon buses.

We will continue to examine and implement additional improvements as feasible and I appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to address these areas.

On a separate note, this year, we will replace the letters that were previously sent home after each verified COVID case with a newly developed COVID Dashboard that is located under the "Important Links" section of the District website. The Dashboard will be updated whenever a positive case is reported and verified. The school nurses, the health department, or District administrators will continue to notify specific individuals if there is a concern for close contact exposure.
