Friday, **April 26, 2019** (evening): Set up free standing display / poster / presentation

Saturday, **April 27, 2019**, 1pm-4pm: SCIENCE FAIR at DEERFIELD SCHOOL! Show off your projects to our judges, faculty, members of the community, and fellow students!

Make sure you have the following before going online:

1. Full names of all participants
2. Email addresses of at least one parent for each participant
3. One project idea (either experiment or demonstration)
4. Short title of your project (10 words or less)
5. Brief explanation of your project (a few sentences)

**DO NOT BUY ANY MATERIALS OR BEGIN YOUR PROJECT UNTIL YOU KNOW THAT IT HAS BEEN APPROVED.**

Participants are required to follow the rules and guidelines outlined in the *Participation Guide* which will be emailed to you when your project is approved. These rules and guidelines serve to promote the ethical principles of scientific research, to ensure the safety of participants and guests, and to maintain a properly organized fair.
